PRACTICE TIME SET UP:

Practices will be: \$20 per half hour, also if you would like to feed your members after their practice, we will be able to set up a lunch special for you. Please contact: Douglas Edens: 540-239-4539

CONTEST TIME – Please note that Siegel High School is in the CENTRAL TIME ZONE(CST) The contest start time will be decided once the entries have been processed. Please check the SCGC website for the draft schedule – www.scgconline.org

SPIEL SHEET: Please make sure your spiel sheet is up to date on the SCGC web site (after logging in, reference the “Manage Unit” section). SCGC will print and hand over the forms to the announcer. Units with incomplete spiel sheets will be announced with the name of the school and hometown only.

ADMISSION: Per SCGC guidelines, admission will be \$10.00 for one day. Kids under 5 years old are free. We will have the ability to accept credit / debit cards. Wrist bands will be provided at unit check in for your team when you arrive.

STAFF AND CHAPERONE PASSES: Five (5) staff/chaperone passes (in the form of wristbands) will be included in your check-in packet. Additional passes for staff / chaperones will be available at the main spectator entrance for your purchase. Your two (2) SCGC Director badges will also be honored; these badges are given to you at unit check in at the very first competition that you attend. We will have the ability to accept credit / debit cards.

UNIT CHECK-IN: Check-in is located at the main front entrance of the school (see map). The spectator entrance will be at the entrance in front of the gym. The doors will be marked with signs. The number of performing members for your unit will be declared at check-in.

PROP / FLOOR UNLOADING AND STORAGE: Floor and props may be dropped off 2 hours prior to performance in the loading dock area behind the gyms (see map) and must be taken back to trucks immediately after your performance. Please note that there is NO PARKING in this area. Floors can be dropped off and then vehicles must proceed to the appropriate parking lots. Guard floors will be stored inside between the gyms prior to your performance.

BODY AND EQUIPMENT WARM UPS: Body warm up will be in the band room and equipment warm up will be in the Auxiliary gym, which is next door to the performance gym (see map). Music will be permitted.

COMPETITION FLOOR AREA: You will enter the competition floor from the front right (Looking at the floor from the audience seating – see map). Exit back right. We will utilize a horizontal time line. A flow chart of the gym area is available in the secured area of the SCGC website under CONTEST INFO and RECAPS.

FLOOR FOLDING / LOADING: We have an area immediately outside of the main gym for folding and loading floors after you perform.

HOSPITALITY: A hospitality room will be available in the Choir room. Please check your map for the location. It will be open only to directors, staff, and judges with the appropriate armband or SCGC badges.

FIRST AID: There is a first aid table located near the competition floor area and can supply basic first aid including band aids, ace bandages or ice packs. We will have medical staff on site in the gym to assess any larger injuries if needed.

RETREAT – CAPTAINS ONLY: Information available with the schedule published by SCGC. Line up for retreat will occur in the auxiliary gym, which is where warm up occurred for the event.

CRITIQUE: Information available with the schedule published by SCGC.

CONCESSIONS: A concession stand is on site in the cafeteria and will include a variety of menu items.

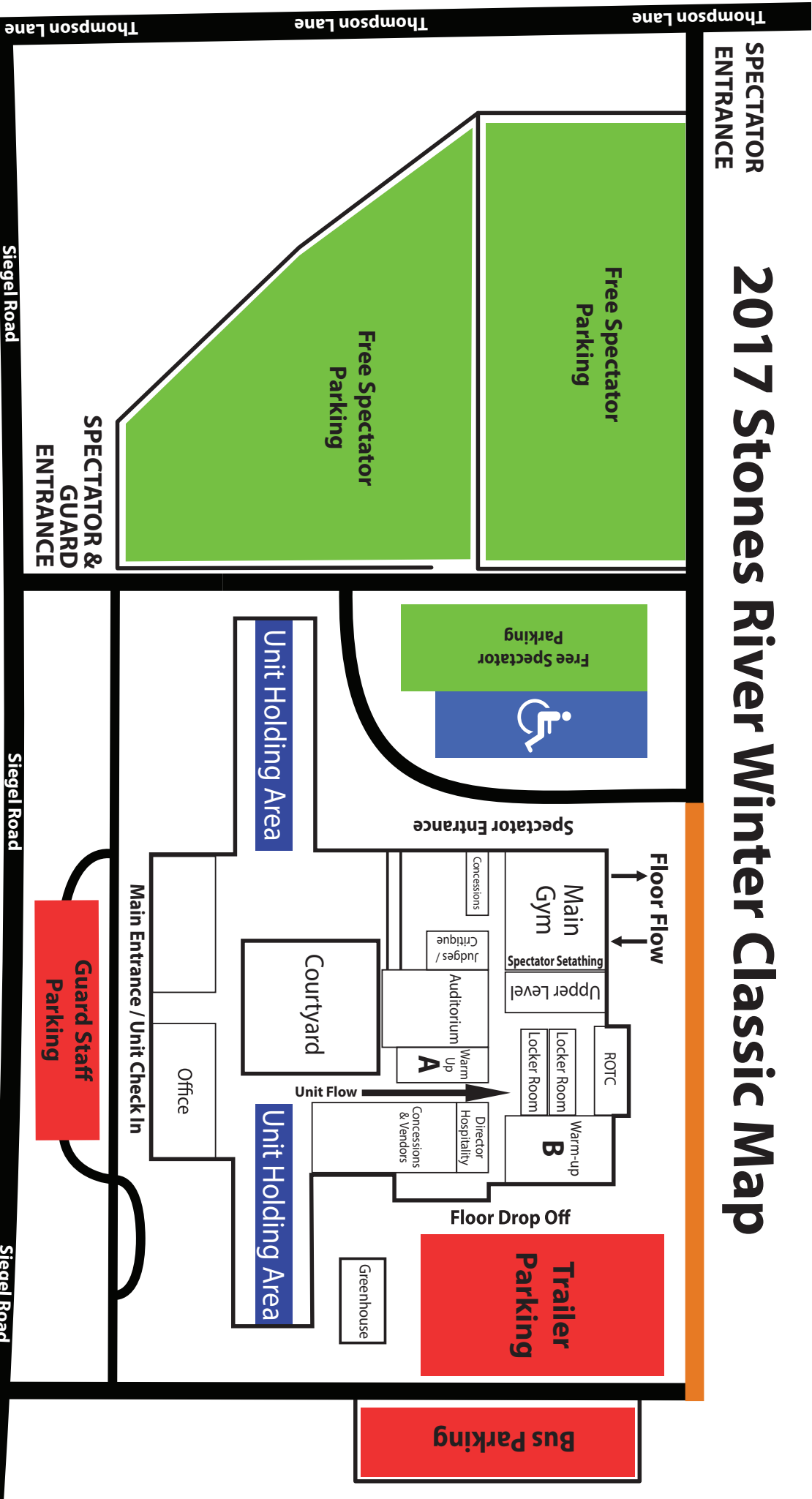
