ADMISSION

Per SCGC guidelines, admission will be \$8.00 for one day. Faculty members and students of Winfield City Schools will be admitted free. Non-performing local groups that wish to bring a group to observe may be offered a group discount at the discretion of the contest sponsor.

STAFF AND CHAPERONE PASSES

5 staff/chaperone passes (wristbands) will be included in your check-in packet. Additional passes for staff/chaperones will be available at the main spectator entrance for purchase. Your two (2) SCGC Director Badges will also be honored.

CONTEST TIME

Information is available with the schedule published by SCGC.

UNIT CHECK-IN

Check-in will be located at the rear entrance of the school at the end of the sidewalk from the bus loop. Buses can unload at the bus loop and continue to bus parking, or performers and directors can walk from the bus parking area to check-in. Follow the posted signs.

PROP/FLOOR COVERING UNLOADING AND STORAGE

Props and floors may be stored in the cafeteria adjacent to the equipment warmup area.

WARM UPS

GUARD BODY: Band Room

EQUIPMENT: Commons

PERCUSSION Bus Parking/Indoor Facility (inclement weather)

COMPETITION FLOOR AREA

Performers enter from the back (stage right) and exit from front (stage right). The floor is a sunken floor design. Please see the attached map.

FLOOR FOLDING

Floors can be refolded on the football practice field immediately behind the gym. Please see the attached map.

CONCESSIONS

A full concession stand will be offered. Please see the attached menu.

HOSPITALITY

A hospitality room will be available in the library. We will be serving hot food for staff and judges and will also have snacks available. The hospitality room will be open to personnel with SCGC Badges.

FIRST AID

A Nurse Practitioner will be on standby in the athletic training room near the gym floor to provide first aid as needed.

SPIEL SHEET

SCGC will print and hand over the forms to the announcer. Please make sure your spiel sheet is up to date. Units with incomplete spiel sheets will be announced with the name of the school and hometown only. To update your form, LOGIN to your account on the SCGC website and go to MANAGE UNIT.

RETREAT

DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO WINFIELD CITY HIGH SCHOOL

* If using a GPS, make sure you enter 232 Pirate Cove, Winfield AL or you may be directed to the Middle School (the old high school) *

FROM NASHVILLE:

Take I-65 South to exit 340A (AL-20 W) toward Decatur for 4.6 miles
Turn Right toward US-72 on Wilson Street NE for 3.4 miles
Turn Left onto AL-67 S, then merge onto AL-24 W for 17.2 miles
Turn Left at the traffic light onto AL-33 S/Market Street for 26.6 miles
Turn Right onto US-278 for 21.1 miles
Turn Left onto AL-129 S for 12.8 miles
Turn Right onto Marion County Road 14 for 3.3 miles
Turn Right onto AL-253 N, then Right onto Pirate Cove toward WCHS

FROM MEMPHIS:

Take I-22 E toward Birmingham to Exit 26
Turn right onto AL-253 S, then Left onto Pirate Cove toward WCHS

FROM BIRMINGHAM:

Take I-22 W toward Memphis to Exit 30 for 162 miles
Turn Left onto AL-129 S for 2.2 miles
Turn Right onto Marion County Road 14 for 3.3 miles
Turn Right onto AL-253 N, then Right onto Pirate Cove toward WCHS
